#### UPCOMING EVENTS

Stated Meeting on February 20th - We will be voting on the following by-laws changes:

- Institute an Executive Committee. The INGL Blue Book requires that this committee be defined in the by-laws and voted on to continue annually. The purpose is to allow the Executive Committee to perform the business of the lodge without taking valuable time at the stated meeting. The Executive Committee will be given a budget at the beginning of the year to pay utilities and subscriptions that the lodge pays annually. The committee will also provide meeting minutes during each stated meeting, so the lodge knows what is going on. All brethren are also welcome to attend the meeting, which takes place on the 2nd Tuesday of the month, or one week prior to the stated meeting.
- Move new officer voting to November Stated Meeting. This provides the officers with more time to get tasks done prior to the end of the year, such as the PM Degree and Officer Installation. This is already being done by several lodges in the area.
- Move May Stated Meeting to 3rd Wednesday. As it stands, our stated meeting coincides with the Annual Communication, which pulls away several of our officers. This can make it difficult to open lodge, let alone get the business that we need done.

**Lodge Workday February 24th** - In order to get the lodge ready to receive our usual breakfast crowd, we will be having a workday to deep clean the kitchen and dining room. Please plan to arrive around 9am and work until done or around noon. We would also like to go out to lunch together after for some social time, if enough participating members are interested.

**Lodge Breakfasts** - As in years past, we will be hosting a breakfast on the first Saturday of the month from 7am - 10am. However, we are expanding the months to March through October. We look forward to seeing you there at our first event on March 2nd.
